THE LONGEST TABLE: July 4th 5pm - 7pm

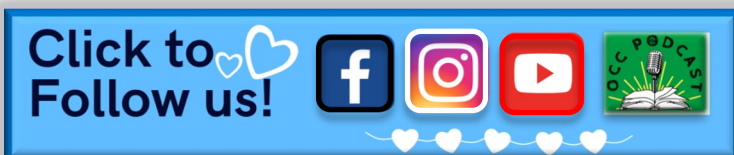
