Acts 4:23-25

²³ When they were released, they went to their friends and reported what the chief priests and the elders had said to them. ²⁴ And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God and said, "Sovereign Lord, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them, ²⁵ who through the mouth of our father David, your servant,[Ⓜ] said by the Holy Spirit, 'Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples plot in vain?' (Acts 4:23-25 ESV)
